

Grand Amour Famed graffiti artist and nightclub entrepreneur André Saraiva—founder of Le Baron in London and Paris, as well as Le Bain at New York's Standard Hotel—opened this sister spot to Hotel Amour this past December. The hotel, renovated by architect Philippe Maidenberg, features hallways painted hot pink and robin's egg blue and decorated with artwork and photography by the likes of Keith Haring and Man Ray.
